



## 19<sup>th</sup> Annual Nantucket Pipe Organ Crawl Saturday, October 8, 2011 COLUMBUS DAY WEEKEND

**DESTINATION EVENT:** The 19<sup>th</sup> Annual Pipe Organ Crawl is a progressive self-guided walking tour where attendees will take in the historical town of Nantucket and enjoy the music of 6 pipe organs played at 5 different churches--all within minutes walking distance of each other. Each mini recital will last approximately 20 minutes, and the performances will demonstrate the range of these unique organs, two of which, the Appleton and the Goodrich, date from 1831 and have been recently restored. This is truly a rare & unique cultural event!

Each organist has chosen a special piece to fully explore the abilities of themselves and the pipe organ—it is a special treat to see both in action!
